More fund raising ideas and plans were discussed. Also, two campouts with Friends in the Safari Field are planned this year with all proceeds to go to the Friends. The dates for these are:

May 12-15, 2011 & Sept. 15-18, 2011.

What is the Friends of Scusset Beach?

The Friends of Scusset Beach is a non-profit group, established in 2009, by a group of people who enjoy and care about Scusset Beach. They are dedicated to supporting specific Scusset Beach State Reservation through volunteer work, fundraising, providing programs & events, and advocacy, and their mission is to aid in care and maintenance of the park.

What does a Friends Group do?

Friends groups undertake a variety of activities. These can include work days at the park to help with a project, organizing fund raisers to help purchase much needed equipment or supplies, or serving as an adovocate for the park when needed.

Friends groups are essential partners in protecting and enhancing DCR's parks. More than 70 groups are working across the state to enhance our forests and parks system.

Who can join the Friends of Scusset Beach?

Anyone who is interested in the care of the Scusset Beach State Reservation is welcome to join.

Your level of involvement is up to you. Some people are very active in their friends groups; serving on the Board of Directors, attending all meetings, working on a specific committee. While other people are content to pay their membership dues knowing that they will go for the support of the park. The level of involvement is up to each individual member.



What has the Friends of Scusset Beach accomplished to date?

- Organization of the Friends of Scusset Beach group and setting up non-profit status for it.
- Attending training for Friends groups in the State.
- Painting the campground camp site numbers and traffic arrows.
- Non-profit status allowed the park to receive a generous donation of power tools from an estate in Plymouth for the park's use.
- Initial fund raising through pancake breakfasts allowing the group to apply for and receive a matching State grant to build a boardwalk from the Jetty parking lot to the Canal service road.
- Attending Park Serve Day this Spring to help prepare the park for Summer visitors.
- Building and dedicating the board walk.
- Activities, park activities, and we have the Scusset Beach newsletter "Sand in Your Shoes".
- A website has also been established for the Friends group.

A Few Words from John....

Winter is finally on its way out. 2011 promises to be another challenging yet exciting year here at Scusset Beach.

Seasonal rosters are out and once again funding is down somewhat. Latest information is the seasonal budget took a 9 % hit. This, for us at least, means shorter seasons for some of our staff. I have not seen the final roster yet so I am not sure if we took position cuts. I do know that our early staff is starting a couple weeks later than normal.

The exciting part, however, is through a stroke of luck we received \$120,000.00 for renovations to the campground bathrooms. While it will not fix all our problems, it will go along way to addressing many of our needs in that building.

The second item is by the hard work of vice president Paul Loiselle, we were once again awarded a Matching partnership grant to start construction on the campground pathways. This was a 2-1 match, which means the Friends are putting in \$1500.00 they raised and the DCR has awarded us \$3000.00 as their part of the project.

The fund raising committee has been hard at work planning and organizing the first of what I hope will be two very successful camping fund raisers. More information on the two that are planned for this season is located on pages 6 & 7 of this newsletter.

Once again, I want to thank everyone for their hard work and dedication to the Friends and to Scusset Beach. Think summer and come get a little sand in your shoes.

On December 15th the grant application was sent out. The total request came to \$4,688. If we are a successful recipient, our share will be \$1,500 with DCR paying \$3,188.66. The grant information says that we will be notified by mid January. The grant was approved in January.
